The Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce supports the recent proposal by the Mayor, Council President Wesson and several members of the Council to create a new pension tier for new City of Los Angeles civilian employees. Requiring a larger employee contribution, increasing the age of retirement, lowering the percentage of pensionable salary, and the other proposed modifications will have a positive long term impact on our pension challenges. We believe this proposal must be passed into law with all due haste.
