A bicycle stairway is a pedestrian stairway that has a channel alongside it to facilitate walking a bicycle up or down the stairway. Bicycle stairs likely arose in reaction to wear and compaction beside outdoor stairways where bicyclists roll the bicycle up or down instead of carrying it or having it bump along the stairs. As the City implements new programs and projects to encourage bicycling as a viable mode of transportation, the Department of Transportation should examine the feasibility of implementing bicycle stairs on outdoor City stairways.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report on the feasibility of implementing bicycle stairs on outdoor City stairways.
