ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to contract funding from the U.S. Department of Energy and Leonardo Technologies, Incorporated for alternative fuel vehicle programmatic support for the Los Angeles Clean Cities Coalition.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, or amendments, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, which may be necessary to secure the awarded grants in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 for alternative fuel vehicle programmatic support for the period, November 1, 2012 until November 15, 2013.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Sanitation to receive contract funds and appropriate up to \$30,000 into the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund, Fund 537, Dept. 50, Account (FY 2013 Clean Cities Programmatic Support).
- 3. AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Sanitation to transfer and appropriate \$21,000 from the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund, Fund 537, Dept. 50, Account (FY 2013 Clean Cities Programmatic Support) to Fund 100, Dept 82, Account 1070, As-Needed Salaries.
- 4. AUTHORIZE the Controller to make technical adjustments as necessary.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The Board of Public Works reports that there is no impact to the City's General Fund. Receipt of up to \$30,000 will offset costs otherwise provided by the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund. The total estimated cost for the project is \$30,000.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On March 6, 2013, the Energy and Environment Committee considered a February 6, 2013 Board of Public Works report relative to contract funding from the U.S. Department of Energy and Leonardo Technologies, Incorporated for alternative fuel vehicle programmatic support for the Los Angeles Clean Cities Coalition. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council concur with the recommendations as reflected above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
