JOB AND BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to drafting an ordinance which would make unpermitted filming a misdemeanor.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Koretz - Alarcón):

REQUEST the City Attorney, with input from the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the Los Angeles Police Department's film unit, to draft an ordinance which would make unpermitted filming a misdemeanor and include the following:.

- a. Notice of warning to be given prior to the issuance of a citation and specify in the ordinance that the citation will move with the property owner and not just the property.
- b. Language that will give the City Attorney discretion in determining the seriousness of the offense.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On April 12, 2011, your Committee considered Motion (Koretz - Alarcón) relative to drafting an ordinance which would make unpermitted filming a misdemeanor.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee acknowledged the need to move this matter forward to Council with the above-mentioned recommendations. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
