COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR, JOBS AND BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Community Development Department (CDD) report relative to the authority to release a Request for Proposal for the new Los Angeles Business Source System (LABSS) PY 2011-2014.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, CDD, or his designee, to release a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the newly designed LABSS.
2. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, CDD, or his designee, to report back to Council the contract agencies selected for the LABSS based on the recommendations of the LABSS RFP review teams, and to seek Council and Mayoral approval to execute contracts with those agencies.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that approval of the above recommendations will have no impact on the General Fund. All elements of the LABSS will be funded by the Community Development Block Grant. The funding recommendations will be contained in the PY 2011-12 Consolidated Plan.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On January 25, 2011, your Committee considered a communication from the CDD relative to the authority to release a RFP for the new LABSS. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee Chair moved to approved the recommendations contained in this report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
