## PROPOSED UPDATE TO THE BICYCLE PLAN, A COMPONMENT OF THE TRANSPORTATION ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN

Dear Councilmembers:

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 551, 555, and 558 of the City Charter, transmitted herewith is the December 16, 2010 action of the City Planning Commission <u>approving</u> a General Plan Amendment to the Transportation Element updating the City's Bicycle Plan. The 2010 Bicycle Plan will designate 1680 miles of bikeways, create three new networks of bicycle facilities (Backbone, Neighborhood, and Green), introduce "Bicycle-Friendly streets", create a Five-Year Implementation Strategy, update goals, objectives, policies, and programs and create a Technical Design Handbook to guide the design of bicycle facilities.
