On Thursday, March 31, 2011, at approximately 8:30 p.m., 41-year old Bryan Stow, and his friends, were followed and confronted by two suspects in the parking lot of Dodger Stadium. The suspects yelled derogatory comments towards the victim and his friends, who ignored the suspects, and continued walking. The suspects continued to follow the victim, at which time, one of the suspects struck the victim in the head with a closed fist, knocking him unconscious. The suspects continued to kick the victim in the head and torso as he lay on the ground. The suspects then fled on foot to a waiting vehicle driven by a third suspect. The victim, Bryan Stow, sustained life threatening head injuries, and is currently receiving medical care at USC Medical Center where he is listed in critical condition. LAPD is still searching for the suspects and encourages witnesses to come forward, even anonymously, to assist them in their investigation. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, OCTOBER 12, 2011.

El martes 31 de marzo de 2011, aproximadamente a las 6:30 p.m., Bryan Stow de 41 años de edad, y sus amigos, fueron seguidos y confrontados por dos sospechosos en el estacionamiento del Estadio de los Dodgers. Los sospechosos gritaron comentarios despectivos hacia la víctima y sus amigos, que no hicieron caso a los sospechosos y siguieron caminando. Los sospechosos continuaron siguiendo a la víctima, y en ese momento, uno de los sospechosos golpeó a la víctima en la cabeza con el puño cerrado, dejándolo inconsciente. Los sospechosos continuaron pateando a la víctima en la cabeza y el torso mientras yacía en el suelo. Los sospechosos huyeron a pie hasta un vehículo que los esperaba conducido por un tercer sospechoso. La víctima, Bryan Stow, continúa con lesiones en la cabeza que amenazan su vida y actualmente se encuentra recibiendo atención médica en la USC Medical Center, donde se encuentra en condición crítica. LAPD sigue buscando a los sospechosos y alerta a los testigos a presentarse, incluso de forma anónima, para ayudarles en su investigación. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles.
