The motive behind the killing is unknown but may be related to road rage or an attempted robbery. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, FEBRUARY 27, 2012.


