Recommendation for Council action:

RECEIVE and FILE the January 3, and May 8, 2014 City Administrative Officer (CAO) First and Second Status Reports relative to the Los Angeles River Projects for 2013-14.

Summary:

On May 12, 2014, your Committee considered January 3 and May 8, 2014 CAO First and Second Status Reports for the Los Angeles River Projects for 2013-14. According to the CAO, on July 2, 2013, Council established the Arts, Parks, Health, Aging and River Committee which assumed oversight of the Los Angeles River related activities previously under the purview of the Ad Hoc Los Angeles River Committee (Council File No. 13-1823). At the request of the Committee, the CAO has prepared a report on the status of Los Angeles River Revitalization projects that are being undertaken by the City. The reports provide information on capital projects relating to or adjacent to the los Angeles River. The summary is based on information provided by project staff from the Bureau of Engineering, the Bureau of Sanitation, the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, and the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.

The CAO then presented an overview of the various projects currently underway and answered questions from the Committee members (a detailed summary is provided in both reports, attached to the Council file). After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to receive and file the two CAO reports. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
