

SUBSTITUTE 1 1

The Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund provides funds for financing community amenities within the City of Los Angeles, within five miles of the Sunshine Canyon landfill.


The Police Department needs funding to eliminate furloughs for civilian Detention Officers and Senior Detention Officers at the new Police Department Metropolitan Detention facility for the rest of the current fiscal year. Eliminating these furloughs will return 27 Los Angeles Police Officers to patrol functions.

Sufficient funds are available in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund which could be loaned to the Police Department for this purpose.


I THEREFORE MOVE that \$639,706 in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 699 be transferred to the Police Department Fund NO. 100-70, Account No. 1010 (Salaries-General) as a loan to eliminate furloughs for the rest of the current fiscal year for civilian Detention Officers, Senior Detention Officers, and Principal Detention Officers assigned to the Los Angeles Police Department Jail Division. The loan will be interest - free, with said funds to be repaid from the General Fund over the next two fiscal years with extension by the approval of the Councilmember of the 12th district, and subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to legality.

I FURTHER MOVE that the city clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
