To Whom It May Concern,

We are constituents that support the well balanced approach of the proposed community care facilities ordinance. My objection is not to sober living homes themselves, but to all boarding houses which cater to transient lodgers which are destroying the nature of low density zones.

We live 3 houses away from the Millinium House South that is located on the corner of Stagg and Texhoma in Northridge, CA 91325. In the 6 years since this house has been operating we have seen upwards of 60 men living there at one time, walking singly or in groups up and down streets to the liquor store or the 7-11 and coming back with alcohol, leaving our streets littered with beer bottles, broken glass and trash. They have been seen trying the locks by lifting the handles on car doors as they walk. There has been an alarming increase in home and auto theft. There has been drug paraphernelia found on the street as well as people parked for periods of time or quick hand offs of items. Mail "missing" from mail boxes and some even found in the facility itself. Men loitering on street curbs, drinking, peering over our fences and tresspassing in our yards taking fruit off our trees without permission. An huge increase in police activity (not the good kind), raids with guns drawn, helicopters and paramedics takings away persons who overdosed or are injured in fights. People cuffed in front of my house and taken to jail. This has got to stop. I no longer let my youngest child (a

teenager) or my grandchildren play in front of the house nor go outside to take out trash or get mail unsupervised. Please help us and push this ordinance to fruition.
