I live right next door to a "sober" living home that currently houses 41 parolees. Here are just a few of the incidents my family has been subjected to.

- *frequent parole checks where police have surrounded our home at gunpoint, lining all the men up in front of MY house in handcuffs
- *monthly drug overdoses
- *panhandling
- *trash thrown in our yard, lit candles thrown in my yard, shoes thrown at my dogs
- * one parolee stood in front of my house, stared at me and my 3 year old daughter, put his hand down his pants and fondled himself *stealing mail from mailboxes
- *my husband had to rescue two female neighbors on a morning walk while be accosted by a parolee
- *seen them purchasing and drinking alcohol
- *checking car doors as they walk by to see if they are unlocked
- *extremely disrespectful "visitors"
- * cigarette smoke is UNBEARABLE, on occasions has caused my baby to cough in OUR OWN HOME

I am not just asking, but pleading with you to please pass the Ordinance that will help us. I obey the law, taxpayer, etc.. yet we are the prisoners. The only thing that separates my family from a neighborhood prison is 6ft wooden fence.
