**reports as follows:**

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the acceptance of grant funding from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the City's Used Tire Recycling Program.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), or designee, to accept an amount not to exceed \$169,602 in grant funds from the CalRecycle Local Government Waste Tire Cleanup and Amnesty Event Grant Programs TCA8 Cycle - Fiscal Year 2010-11 to fund all eligible expenses incurred during the grant term for the City's Used Tire Recycling Program, and to execute all necessary agreements, amendments and payment requests which may be necessary to secure funding.
2. AUTHORIZE the BOS to deposit up to \$169,602 in grant receipts into the Solid Waste Resources Revenue Fund, Fund 508, Department 50, Revenue Source Code 336100 (Other State Grants-General).
3. ADOPT the accompanying Resolution authorizing the acceptance of the grant funding.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The BOS reports that there is no impact to the General Fund. Receipt of grant funds will offset costs otherwise provided by the Solid Waste Resources Revenue Fund. The total estimated cost for the grant project is \$169,602.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 27, 2011, your Committee considered reports from the Board of Public Works and from the BOS relative to the acceptance of grant funding from the CalRecycle for the City's Used Tire Recycling Program. The reports, attached to the Council file, provide additional details on this issue. During the discussion of this item, the BOS representatives provided an overview of the Bureau's request and responded to related questions from the Committee members. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendations reflected above.

This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
