### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Community Facilities District No. 9 (Downtown Streetcar) Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 182193 to place a measure before voters within the designated boundary and the election was held December 3, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles Community Facilities District No. 9 (Downtown Streetcar):

# DOWNTOWN STREETCAR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT

Shall City of Los Angeles Community Facilities District No. 9 (Downtown Streetcar) be authorized to incur bonded indebtedness in a maximum amount of not to exceed \$85,000,000 and levy a special tax in order to finance certain facilities and shall the annual appropriations limit of said Community Facilities District be established in the amount of \$85,000,000, all as specified in Ordinance No. 182191 and Ordinance No.182192?

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Clerk, in accordance with City of Los Angeles Charter Section 404, did canvass the returns of the Special Community Facilities District No. 9 (Downtown Streetcar) Election held in the City of Los Angeles on December 3, 2012, and certified them to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.
