Re: Protest to Establishment of Los Angeles Tourism Marketing District and Levy of Special Assessments

To Whom It May Concern:

The Los Angeles Athletic Club formally protests the proposed formation, and our Club's inclusion in Appendix 2, of the Los Angeles Tourism Marketing District Management District Plan as a "Lodging Business."

The Club is a private membership club with restricted access to its facilities. We are not primarily in the lodging business. As a private club, our facilities are not open to the general public, nor do our guest rooms constitute "public accommodations." The general public cannot walk-in off the street and rent one of our guest rooms.

Private Clubs should not be included as lodging establishments subject to the proposed ordinance since they cater primarily to their members who are already residents of the area and these members would not receive a "special benefit" by the formation of the tourism marketing district.

If private clubs are, however, included in the special assessment district, we ask that the revenues from members, or principals or affiliates who reside in the area and stay in the guest rooms be excluded.
