## FROM: COUNCILMEMBER JOSE HUIZAR, CHAIR ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE and RESOLUTION relative to the authority to accept \$950,000 in grant funds from the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committees (MSRC) 2012 Local Government Match Program for the Clean Fuel Program for Solid Resources Collection Vehicles.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. APPROVE the April 19, 2013 Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) report as attached to the Council file.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Director of the BOS, or designee, to accept \$950,000 in grant funds from the MSRC, to conduct all negotiations, to provide additional information, and to execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, agreements, amendments, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality necessary to secure funding with respect to the purchase of 32 heavy duty natural gas powered Solid Resources Collection Vehicles (SRCV). Authority to apply for grant funding was authorized on March 8, 2012 per Council File No. 11-0527 (Transmittal No. 1).
- 3. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION (Transmittal No. 2) approving the acceptance of grant funding amount of \$950,000 and appointing the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents necessary to accept and expend grant funding for the purchase of 32 heavy-duty natural gas powered SRCV.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The Board reports that the receipt of grant funds will enable the City to reduce the cost of purchasing 32 heavy duty natural gas powered SRCV from the Solid Waste Resources Revenue Bonds, Series 2013-A. Failure to accept funds in the amount \$950,000 from the MSRC will eliminate this funding available to the City of Los Angeles to help offset the cost of new SRCV. There is no negative financial impact on the General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

#### Summary:

On May 1, 2013, the Chair of the Energy and Environment Committee considered an April 19, 2013 BOS report and Resolution relative to the authority to accept \$950,000 in grant funds from the MSRC 2012 Local Government Match Program for the Clean Fuel Program for Solid Resources Collection Vehicles. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee Chair recommended approval of the BOS report and Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.

#### RESOLUTION

TRANSMITTAL 2

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) was directed by Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa to convert the City Los Angeles fleet of Solid Resources Collection Vehicles (SRCV) to clean-burning natural gas powered vehicles; and

WHEREAS, for solid resources collection fleets operating in the South Coast Air Basin, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Fleet Rule 1193 requires operators to acquire alternative-fuel heavy-duty SRCV when procuring or leasing these vehicles to reduce air toxic and criteria pollutant emissions; and

WHEREAS, the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee (MSRC) released the 2012 Local Government Match Program Announcement on March 2, 2012, to co-fund qualifying heavy-duty vehicle projects implemented by cities and counties that utilize their Motor Vehicle Registration Fee Subvention Funds (AB 2766 Subvention Funds); and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Council and Mayor adopted a resolution on March 8, 2012 authorizing the Director of BOS, or designee, to apply for external grant funding opportunities for the BOS Clean Fuel Program (C.F. 11-0527); and

WHEREAS, the BOS participated in the 2012 MSRC Local Government Match Program with the proposed project to purchase 32 qualified natural gas fueled heavy-duty SRCV with 2010 compliant engines and certified with enhanced NOx emission reduction; and

WHEREAS, the BOS was notified that its grant application to the 2012 Local Government Match Program has been selected for a "dollar for dollar" match award of \$950,000 for the project allocation of \$700,000 from the Subvention Funds and the maximum allowable allocation of \$250,000 from the Solid Waste Resources Revenue Bonds Series 2013-A to partially offset the purchase cost of 32 natural gas heavy-duty SRCV; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that by adoption of this Resolution, with the concurrence of the Mayor, that the City Council authorizes the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to execute all necessary contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests for the purposes of securing the 2012 Local Government Match Program grant funds in the maximum amount of \$950,000, and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.
