DRAFT ORDINANCE TO RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 011-230 AND APPROVE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SEVEN QUITCLAIM DEEDS FOR LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER (LADWP) DISTRIBUTION EASEMENTS

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. This draft ordinance would rescind the previous Resolution No. 011-230 dated April 5, 2011, and approve the amended Resolution to quitclaim seven LADWP distribution easements and to remove Item 1 from the previous Resolution No. 011-230.

Background

On April 5, 2011, the LADWP adopted Resolution No. 011-230 to execute a Quitclaim Deed of eight Water and Power distribution easements. The Requestors have already paid the processing fee of \$4,250.00.

Item No. 1 of said Quitclaim Deed is for the right and easement to construct, maintain and operate lines of poles and wires for the transmission of electrical energy

and telephonic and telegraphic messages through and over a portion of Lot 1, Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 16 West, of the San Bernardino Meridian, more particularly described in a document recorded in Book 3742, page 233 of Deeds, in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

Initially the affected facility for Item No. 1 was identified as Power System assets only, and the request was directed to the Power System group for review. When the matter was scheduled before City Council, the ordinance was missing; in effect, no action was taken. Subsequently, it was determined that Water System has assets nearby and they should have been consulted. When Water System reviewed the matter, it was determined that quitclaiming the subject easement would have impacted LADWP's surface and air rights for the First Los Angeles Aqueduct.

Now action is needed on the remaining seven items (i.e., Items 2 though 8, inclusive), which are included in the amended Resolution.

Charter Compliance

This ordinance is transmitted for your approval pursuant to Charter Section 675, after approval by the Board of Commissioners for the Department of Water and Power.

CEQA Findings

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), it has been determined that this work is exempt from further requirements under the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines, Article III, Class 5(4), Categorical Exemption.

Recommendation

The City Administrative Officer (CAO) analyzed and recommends approval of this transaction, as well as the Board of Commissioners for the Department of Water and Power. A copy of the CAO report and the Board Resolution are also provided for your convenience.

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ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance approving a Resolution of the Board of Water and Power Commissioners authorizing the execution of seven quitclaim deeds for seven Los Angeles Water and Power (LADWP) distribution easements.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Except for Item 1, which is intentionally omitted, it is found and determined that certain easements described in this ordinance, owned by the City of Los Angeles and under the management and control of the Department of Water and Power, are no longer required for the use of the City, and should be abandoned and quitclaimed. The Board of Water and Power Commissioners has adopted an Amended Resolution abandoning these easements, determining that they should be quitclaimed, and requesting the City Council to authorize by ordinance the execution, acknowledgment, and delivery of an instrument in writing, as provided in Sections 675(d)(2) of the Los Angeles City Charter, quitclaiming said easements to the owners of record. Said Amended Resolution is hereby approved.

Sec. 2. Quitclaiming of these easements is hereby authorized and ordered. The execution of the appropriate instruments by the President or Vice President of the Board of Water and Power Commissioners or the General Manager of the Department is hereby authorized, and each of them is empowered, and directed to execute in the name of the City of Los Angeles, an instrument or instruments in writing, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, quitclaiming to the owners of record those certain easements described in Items 2 to 8, inclusive, as follows:

PURPOSE

Your Honorable Board is requested to rescind previous Resolution No: 011-230 dated April 5, 2011 and approve the attached amended Resolution to quitclaim seven (7) LADWP distribution easements.

There is no cost to LADWP. The processing fee of \$4,250 will be returned.

BACKGROUND

On April 5, 2011, the LADWP entered into Resolution No. 011-230 to execute a Quitclaim Deed of eight (8) Water and Power distribution easements. The eight (8) requestors have already paid the processing fee of \$4,250.

Item No. 1 of said Quitclaim Deed is for the right and easement to construct, maintain and operate lines of poles and wires for the transmission of electrical energy and telephonic and telegraphic messages through and over a portion of Lot 1, Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 16 West, of the San Bernardino Meridian, more particularly described in a document recorded in Book 3742, page 233 of Deeds, in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

Initially, the affected facility for Item No. 1 was identified as Power System assets only and the request was directed to the Power System group for review. Board of Water and Power Commissioners Page 2 November 1, 2012

When the matter was scheduled before the Los Angeles City Council, the Ordinance was missing; in effect, the Council took no action.

Subsequently, it was determined that Water System has assets nearby and they should have been consulted. When Water System reviewed the matter, it was determined that quitclaiming the subject easement would have impacted LADWP's surface and air rights for the First Los Angeles Aqueduct. This results in a quitclaim of seven (7), rather than eight (8) easements. This request and the history of the situation is described in more detail in the enclosed City Administrative Officer Memorandum.

No action is needed on the remaining seven (7) items (i.e. items 2 though 8, inclusive) and are included in the amended Resolution.

SUMMARY

The Department of Water and Power (DWP; Department) requests approval of a proposed resolution which authorizes the DWP to quitclaim (to release or relinquish a legal claim) seven water and power distribution easements. The DWP has determined that these easements are no longer required for use by the Department. Charter Section 675(d)(2) requires Council approval to dispose of real property. The City Attorney has approved the proposed resolution as to form and legality.

This request is a revision of a previous Resolution No. 011-230 adopted by the Board of Water and Power Commissioners (Board) on April 2011 which called for the quitclaim of eight easements. However, due to the omission of an ordinance before the City Council to approve the previous action by the Board, the action was never approved. Currently, the property owners have requested that DWP provide them with the deeds to their property; therefore, DWP is resubmitting the request with a revision to the number of claims to be considered decreased from eight to seven.

The reason the revision is required is that the initial Resolution by the Board was acted upon and the revision needed to be corrected for the record. The first parcel was originally reviewed for Power System needs and not by the Water System. A second review indicates that the parcel is located over a portion of Lot 1, Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 16 West, of the San Bernardino Meridian, which impacts DWP's surface and air rights for the First Los Angeles Aqueduct. The proposed Resolution deletes the first quitclaim and retains the remaining seven.

Background

The Department periodically reviews applications requesting the Department to abandon DWP owned easements. The requests are from property owners who often are trying to remove easement restrictions that had been required for building permits or tract maps. If the Department determines that an easement is no longer necessary for current or future DWP operations, a quitclaim deed is processed which transfers the rights of the easement to the existing property owner, thereby,

effectively terminating the easement. The DWP states that the each of the eight applicants paid DWP a processing fee. This rate is consistent with the Board action which established new requirements for quitclaim deeds that increased the processing fee to a minimum of \$4,250. There is no other cost from the Department to a property owner who requests a quitclaim. Since the first quitclaim has been denied, a refund shall be provided to that property owner.

Upon review of the attached DWP request, it is the opinion of this Office that the item can be approved, as the requested action appears to be reasonable and in accordance with City policies and procedures.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Mayor:

- Approve the proposed resolution which authorizes the Department of Water and Power to remove the first quitclaim and execute quitclaim deeds for seven Water and Power distribution easements as provided for in the resolution; and
- 2. Return the proposed resolution to the Department for further processing, including Council consideration.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the proposed resolution will result in revenue to the Water Revenue Fund and Power Revenue Fund totaling \$29,750. The Department of Water and Power Debt Management Policies are not applicable. Approval of the proposed resolution will have no impact on the City's General Fund.

TIME LÍMIT FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Pursuant to Charter Section 675(d)(2), "Powers and Duties of the Board – Real Estate Interests," subject to the water rights of the City, there is no time limit for Council action on agreements for real property or any rights in real property held by DWP that will be sold, leased or withdrawn from the Department's control.
