SUBJECT: TRANSMITTAL OF THE EXTENSION FOR THE 2009 COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) TECHNOLOGY GRANT PROGRAM

### **RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

- 1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE this report.
- That the Board TRANSMIT the report concurrently to the Mayor and City Council. 2.
- 3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council to:
  - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or designee to ACCEPT the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ) COPS Office's approval of a no cost extension for the 2009 COPS Technology Grant, extending the award period from March 10, 2015 to September 10, 2016;
  - B. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

### DISCUSSION

In 2009, the USDOJ COPS Office awarded the City \$500,000 for the COPS Technology grant. The award provides funding for the development of a mass notification system to ensure rapid delivery of critical alerts, warnings and instructional messages to City residents and businesses during disasters, emergencies, and other significant Citywide events.

Initially, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) initiated a contract with the County of Los Angeles to allow the use of the Alert LA County emergency notification system. Payments to the County were on a "pay as you go" basis depending on usage. In the process of doing tests and sending out targeted notifications, process delays and system failures were encountered prompting the City to re-evaluate purchasing its own system.

In June 2014, LAPD purchased the Nixle mass notification system using the COPS Technology grant. With the Nixle system, Emergency Services Division then launched NotifyLA, which is a free, automated system used to send out alerts to the public about emergency and critical incidents. NotifyLA can reach the public via recorded telephone messages, text messages and emails. This

information will keep the public informed when a disaster occurs and will provide preemptive warnings in some cases.

The approval of this transmittal will allow the City of Los Angeles to expend grant funds to continue the use of the Nixle mass notification system and to market "NotifyLA".
