The Bureau of Engineering has reviewed the application submitted to change the community name of a neighborhood in the northern part of San Fernando Valley as Porter Ranch. This area is commonly known as Porter Ranch. This application would officially set the boundaries of the community.

There are approximately 8,022 properties with an estimated population from the 2010 census of 21,060 people in five census tracts. This community is entirely within Council District 12 and completely within the Porter Ranch Neighborhood Council boundary. The community plan area is called Chatsworth-Porter Ranch and there is a specific plan for Porter Ranch.

The attached maps show the parcels in the area that are proposed to be included in the new community as shown on the application and shows the boundaries of the council districts, community plans, and historical community boundaries.

The Bureau of Engineering has no additional pertinent information concerning the historical use of this name for this neighborhood in the community.




