- 1. REQUEST the City Attorney to draft an Ordinance that would merge the grievance procedure and the complaint process into one system.
- 2. INSTRUCT the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) to establish a single set of procedures with a regional grievance panel empowered to render a final decision on a grievance without further right of administrative appeal, which shall be based on the grievance policy recommendations already made by the DONE as reflected in its report dated November 22, 2011, attached to the Council file.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on November 4, 2013, the Budget and Finance (BF) Committee considered a report from the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners and DONE relative to recommendations to combine the existing grievance and complaint procedures into one system with a final decision to be made by a regional grievance panel.

During discussion of this matter, the General Manager of DONE provided background information on this matter and responded to related questions from Committee members. After further consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the BF Committee recommended to concur with the recommendations of the Education and Neighborhoods Committee as amended. Additionally, the BF Committee recommended several amendments including adding an effective date of July 1, 2014, requesting a budget proposal from DONE to be evaluated as part of the 2014-15 budget process, and requesting a report back from DONE in order to evaluate the effectiveness of the new system. These amendments are reflected in the recommendations above.

This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
