MOTION

On May 8, 2012, the Los Angeles City Council adopted an ordinance to require the on-site containment of shopping carts for new retail stores and stores undergoing major renovations that will utilize greater than six carts.

Since the adoption and implementation of the ordinance, the Bureau of Street Services (BSS) has determined that they do not have the capacity to enforce and monitor the on-site shopping cart requirements outlined in the ordinance.

The Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) has assisted in the development of the ordinance and has advised this office that it is willing and capable of assuming responsibility of enforcing and implementing the intent of the ordinance.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Attorney be requested to prepare and present an ordinance to transfer responsibility and authority for the implementation and enforcement of the on-site shopping cart requirements from the Bureau of Street Services to the Bureau of Sanitation.

I FURTHER MOVE that Bureau of Sanitation, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer, be directed to identify the necessary resources and funding to effectuate the transfer of responsibility.
