STATEMENT of J.H. McQUISTON on MODIFIED PARKING REQUIREMENT AMENDMENT

Honorable Chairman and Members of the Committee:

323-464-6792

One subsection of the Amendment may put pedestrians at risk of death or injury.

I suggest that the Council amend Section 13.15 F 2 to reduce the risk to persons parking in remote lots, by inserting a sentence at its end:

" If the distance from off-street parking-space to the door of the destination measures more than 700 feet, along the pedestrian walkway per this Section, the walkway shall always have light with a minimum intensity of two (2) foot-candles, and the parking lot and route to the door of the destination shall be equipped with surveillance equipment or a watchman."

The above sentence is required to provide minimum safety to those persons which may otherwise be attacked by predators.

The Transportation-Engineer norm for pedestrian-walking from parked auto to door is 700 feet for this area. People are fearful if longer distance walking is required. Handicapped-parking laws are also a consideration.
