The neighborhood surrounding Runyon Canyon has two Preferential Parking Districts which provide assures parking is available for the neighborhood residents. As the popularity of Runyon Canyon continues to increase with the public, street parking has been adversely impacted the quality of life for the residents in the immediate area.

Access to park in front of their properties, disruption of trash pick up, street cleaning services, and excessive foot traffic have resulted from the visitors to Runyon Canyon.

The residents in the area are seeking immediate relief from this parking problem and have concluded that modification is needed on the existing Preferential Parking Districts (PPD#76 & PPD#112) to include restrictions on weekends and holidays.

On Tuesday July 26, 2011 the Arts, Parks, Health and Aging Committee had an open discussion which no action was taken on this issue regarding the impacts that the surrounding neighborhoods are facing due to the increased popularity of Runyon Canyon Park.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Department of Transportation be directed to report with recommendation for expanding the restrictions of Preferential Parking Districts #76 and #112.
