PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending Section 87.53 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to ensure that the City is regulating mobile billboards to the maximum legal authority allowed by the California Vehicle Code (CVC).

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Bonin):

REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation and the Los Angeles Police Department, to review Section 87.53 of the LAMC and to prepare and present an ordinance that amends LAMC Section 87.53 to ensure that the City is regulating mobile billboards to the maximum legal authority allowed by the CVC.
