Your PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

reports as follows:

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE relative to an application fee for charitable solicitation information cards, increasing the fees for issuance of News Media Identification Cards and False Alarms, and revising the entire fee schedule for Police Permits.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. PRESENT and ADOPT accompanying ORDINANCE amending Sections 44.04, 52.16, 103.12, and 103.206 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) by adding an application fee for charitable solicitation information cards, increasing the fees for issuance of News Media Identification Cards and False Alarms, and revising the entire fee schedule for Police Permits.
2. INSTRUCT the Police Department to identify additional businesses and activities which generate significant enforcement activities and report on the feasibility of permitting those businesses.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that the proposed fee increase will generate an estimated additional \$300,000 per year in revenue for the City. This action is in compliance with City financial policies as the proposed fees are fair and recover the full cost of providing such services.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

Accompanying a report to Council dated September 8, 2011 (attached to Council file No. 11-0600-S128), the City Attorney presents Ordinance amending the LAMC to revise and increase police permit fees and to add an application fee for charitable solicitation information cards. Included in the ordinance is the schedule of fees. In a report to the Mayor dated September 23, 2011 (attached to Council file No. 11-1625), the CAO discusses the methodology used to calculate the proposed fee increases. According to the CAO, many current police permit fees do not fully recover the costs of services provided by the Police Department. The CAO recommends approval of the Police Department's proposed permit fee increases.

At its meeting held September 30, 2011, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve the accompanying Ordinance described above, as recommended by the CAO.
