In 2011 the City created the Los Angeles Food Policy Council as an independent non-profit organization to encourage the production and consumption of healthy, affordable and sustainable food. Subsequently, on October 24, 2012, the City Council unanimously adopted Council File 11-1678 establishing Good Food Purchasing Guidelines and local food procurement goals, and urging adoption of the Good Food Purchasing Pledge by all City departments involved with food procurement. This action was underscored by the issuance of Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa's Executive Directive No. 24 on the same date, which reaffirmed and expanded upon the Council's action.

On October 16, 2013, the City Administrative Officer issued a progress report noting that the Los Angeles Unified School District, but few City departments, had adopted the Good Food Purchasing Pledge. In 2014, the L.A. Food Policy Council issued a follow-up report (Council File 14-0555) noting that Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) was among the City food procuring entities that should be encouraged to make additional progress in this issue area.

Council File 15-1103 pertains to a number of LAWA concession agreements, some of which involved food and beverage services, which are being amended and restated. LAWA represents that these agreements were originally adopted prior to the adoption of the Good Food Purchasing Guidelines and thus do not contain language indicating a commitment to implementing those Guidelines.

LAWA as well all the other Proprietary Departments should be encouraged to step up the pace of their efforts to incorporate the Good Food Purchasing Guidelines as a regular element of their food and beverage-related concession agreements.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Airport, Harbor and Water and Power departments be requested to comply with the City's Good Food Purchasing Guidelines by incorporating in all future amended, restated and new concession agreements involving food and beverage services the goal of compliance with the Good Food Purchasing Guidelines and local food procurement goals established in CF 11-1678 and Mayoral Executive Directive 24 issued on October 24, 2012.
