## BABCNC Board Resolution on Revised City Sign Ordinance Motion Council File# 11-1705 (having been changed from 08-2020) for Community Impact Statement

We, Travis Longcore, Ph.D. and Nickie Miner, declare that we are the President and Vice President respectively of the Bel Air Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council, and that on June 24, 2015, a Brown Act noticed public meeting was held by the Bel Air Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council, and, with a quorum of 15 board members present, the Bel Air Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council unanimously resolved by all Board members voting, that it endorses the following positions on digital signs:

- 1. Digital signs to be placed only within sign districts (and none outside of sign districts).
- 2. Mandatory takedown requirement of minimum of 4 signs for each new sign erected.
- 3. No grandfathering or "amnesty" of billboards erected without permits or altered in violation of their permits. Enforcement / removal of illegally altered or erected signage/billboards.
- 4. Passage of the Sign Ordinance as soon as possible in its current form (without attempts to turn back on the now illegal/turned off digital signs) and with its strong penalty provisions for noncompliance.
