RE: Council File 11-1735 - Motion for East Hollywood Over-height Fence District

Dear Councilman O'Farrell, Mr. LoGrande and Mr. Chan:

At a special meeting of the Hollywood Studio District Neighborhood Council (HSDNC) on Wednesday, October 22nd, the Board voted unanimously to support a 6-month extension (with the option to extend for another 6 months at the end of that period) for further consideration, input and review of the motion cited above.

This motion provided for the creation of an over-height fence district partially located in the Hollywood Studio District. The motion was proposed by former CD-13 Councilman and now Mayor Garcetti, and was unanimously approved by the full City Council on October 19, 2011.

We are informed that the period for review of this motion will expire January 4, 2015. Because of the serious concerns of our community members and stakeholders who are affected by this, the HSDNC felt that it best to support more time to allow these community members, stakeholders and those most affected to have time to fully consider the motion as currently proposed and offer input for its revision, clarification and improvement.

The HSDNC is hopeful that issues raised by its stakeholders and members of its community will have a chance to be heard and incorporated into the motion.

The Board also expressed concern for those working families who were issued substantial fines without proper time to cure and despite implementation of this motion. We hope that efforts will be made to dismiss or forgive these, especially as the motion is extended or renewed.
