reports as follows:

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE relative to the first amendments to a contract with Verizon California, Inc. and with L Tech Network Services, Inc. for occasional and temporary communications and network services.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. AUTHORIZE the General Manager of the Information Technology Agency (ITA) to execute Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Verizon California, Inc., for occasional and temporary communications and network services, to extend the term of the contract by two years until October 5, 2013, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.
2. AUTHORIZE the General Manager of the ITA to execute Amendment No. 1 to the contract with L Tech Network Services, Inc., for occasional and temporary communications and network services, to extend the term of the contract by two years until October 5, 2013, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that no specific projects will be initiated as a result of the amendments to this contract. Projects will only be pursued under these amendments if funding is first authorized. It is projected that the cumulative annual expenditure on these two contracts will be \$2.15 million. Funding will be provided by a variety of budgeted and available sources. Approving the recommendations in this report is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies.
