COMMENTS

In accordance with Executive Directive No. 3, the Information Technology Agency (ITA) requests approval to execute Amendment No. 2 (Amendment) to two contracts, one with Verizon California, Inc. (Verizon) (C-110665) and the other with L Tech Network Services, Inc. (L Tech) (C-110666), to provide communications and network services. In each case, the contract is proposed to be extended by two years for a total contract term of nine years from October 6, 2006 through October 5, 2015. The expenditure limit will remain \$20,000,000 per contract.

Both contractors were selected through a 2005 Request for Proposals (RFP) process. Work is awarded to either Verizon or L Tech following their submission of cost estimates for specific projects. ITA states that it intends to perform a new RFP process in 2014.

While ITA administers these contracts, work is performed for any City department that makes a communication services request to ITA if that work exceeds ITA's staffing capacity. Projects are either a) fully funded by budgeted funds within ITA's Communications Services Account, b) funded by interim appropriations to ITA's Communications Services Account from other departments, or c) in the case of large projects, funded directly by the requesting department. ITA's 2013-14 budget includes approximately \$860,000 for work that can be performed under these contracts. The cumulative

average annual expenditure for these two contracts during the current seven year term was \$2.22 million. Cumulative expenditures to date total \$15.56 million. Examples of projects that will require services through these contracts include the installation of cabling to link the servers at the Personnel Building and the installation of Wi-Fi for the Bureau of Sanitation at the Public Works Building.

In accordance with Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5(a), the City Council approval of the proposed Amendments is required because the contracts exceed three years in term. According to ITA, Verizon and L Tech have complied with all contracting requirements, policies, and procedures.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council approve, and authorize the General Manager of the Information Technology Agency to execute, Amendments No. 2 to the contracts with Verizon California, Inc. and L Tech Network Services, Inc. to provide communications and network services, to extend the terms of the contracts by two years until October 5, 2015, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Funding for the contracts will be provided by budgeted funds within either the Information Technology Agency's Communications Services Account or departmental budgets. As budgeted funds are available to fund the proposed Amendment expenditures, the recommendation of this report complies with the City's Financial Policies.

REQUEST FOR PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT – VERIZON CALIFORNIA, INC. AND L-TECH NETWORK SERVICES,

INC.

Dear Mayor Garcetti:

In accordance with Executive Directive No. 3, attached for your review and approval is a personal services contract amendment to Contract numbers C-110665 and C-110666. This amendment will permit Verizon California, Inc. (Verizon) and L-Tech Network Services, Inc. (L-Tech) to continue providing communications and network services as specified in the contract without disruption for up to an additional two years beyond the seven year term of the contract. This amendment does not change the total compensation limit.

Background

On March 6, 2006, an Executive Directive No. 3 letter (REF: OPA-169-06) and two draft personal services contracts for citywide communication related services were submitted to your office for review and approval. As stated in the letter, the Information Technology Agency (ITA) recommended award of contracts to Verizon California, Inc. and L-Tech Network Services, Inc. Subsequently, two five year contracts (C-110665 and C-110666) were executed on October 6, 2006 for the provision of communications and network services. The first amendment to each contract (C-110665 and C-110666) to extend the term for two additional years were executed on June 12, 2012 and December 14, 2011 respectively. Both contracts are set to expire on October 5, 2013.

The communications and network services covered under these contracts are critical to the City's daily business. The contracts provide for the operation and maintenance of the City's private branch exchange (PBX) telephone switches, telephone repair services, installation of structured cabling and related administrative and clerical duties on an as needed, intermittent basis. The contracts provide services to all Council

Controlled Departments and are funded either through ITA's budget allocation or from inter-departmental transfers.

ITA has prepared a new Request for Proposals (RFP) which ITA plans to release within the next month. However, based on experience with the RFP process, ITA will not have sufficient time to execute replacement contract(s) before the current contracts expires in approximately six weeks. ITA needs to extend the term of the two current contracts to afford ITA the tool to continue providing service Citywide without disruption to daily City business while simultaneously moving through with the competitive process.

ITA is requesting an extension of the current contracts for up to two years. The annual amount of each contract is not to exceed \$4,000,000 per year for a cumulative total of \$20,000,000 for five years. The total expenditure for each contract (from October 6, 2006 through July 2013) is less than \$10,000,000, so ITA is not requesting to increase the total contract cap for either contract. The execution of these contracts does not obligate the City to utilize all the contractors' services or all the allocated funds. The contracts are also subject to termination by the City if funds are not appropriated for the services in any ensuing fiscal year commencing July 1.

The CAO has opined that pursuant to Charter 1022 policy, since this amendment does not add new labor component and the contract amount previously approved for the existing labor component remains the same, a new Charter 1022 process is not required.

Both contractors have complied with all City administrative requirements for personal services contracts of this type. In addition, the contractors have maintained the required insurance, although Verizon's insurance recently expired which the vendor will update at the City's Risk Management track4la website. These contract amendments have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney as to form.


