<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that no specific projects will be initiated as a result of the amendments to this contract. Projects will only be pursued under these amendments if funding is first authorized. It is projected that the cumulative annual expenditure on these two contracts will be \$2.15 million. Funding will be provided by a variety of budgeted and available sources. Approving the recommendations in this report is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies.
