## SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor and Council dated October 17, 2013, the City Clerk states that the fund balance for the Council District 12 Los Angeles Police Department Devonshire and Foothill Divisions Police Assistance Trust Fund No. 883 was \$135.65 as of June 30, 2012. The Fund realized net revenue in the amount of \$2.42, and total expenditures and encumbrances in the amount of \$0.00, leaving a balance of \$138.07 as of June 30, 2013. According to the City Clerk, the Fund was established in 1994 for the receipt, retention, and disbursements of gifts, contributions, and for the operation of the Los Angeles Police Department's Devonshire and Foothill Divisions.

At its meeting held November 8, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council note and file the City Clerk's report.
