PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an amendment and additions to Section 62.02 Article 2, Chapter VI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code strengthening requirements for utility contractors working in the public right-of-way.

Recommendations for Council action:

- REQUEST the City Attorney to work with the Bureau of Contract Administration to amend Section 62.02(f)2., Article 2, Chapter VI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to modify the exception to requiring utility companies and their contractors to provide liability insurance.
- REQUEST the City Attorney to work with the Bureau of Contract Administration to amend Section 62.02(g), Article 2, Chapter VI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to require all utility owners to provide to the Bureau of Contract Administration (Inspector of Public Works), written affidavits designating their authorized representative who will be performing the work described in a permit.
- REQUEST the City Attorney to work with the Bureau of Contract Administration to amend Section 62.04(b), Article 1, Chapter VI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to include notification requirements on permits for utility service work cuts of less than 100 square feet.
- 4. REQUEST the City Attorney, City Administrative Officer, and the Bureau of Contract Administration to report back within 90 days with recommendations to increase the City's current fines and penalties associated with failing to comply with the City's permit requirements.

<u>Eiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Board of Public Works. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## **SUMMARY**

At a regular meeting held on September 17, 2014, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Board of Public Works report relative to an amendment and additions to Section 62.02 Article 2, Chapter VI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code strengthening requirements for utility contractors working in the public right-of-way. Bureau of Contract Administration staff gave an overview of the matter.
