## SUMMARY

The Council adopted a Motion on November 30, 2011 directing the Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst to report back on the costs for salaries, overtime, and other expenses related to the Occupy LA protest that occurred primarily in City Hall Park during the months of October and November 2011 (C.F. 11-2004). In response to the Motion, this Office released a report on December 23, 2011 which provided the relevant costs reported to the CAO by various Departments. That report was updated on May 10, 2012 with additional costs for the Police Department, the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), and costs for repair of the Flint Fountain, Bill of Rights Memorial, and Braude Bench. This final report updates costs for the Office of the City Attorney to reflect post Occupy LA costs for that office of an additional \$61,430. The attached table details regular salary, overtime, and supplies/equipment costs--plus donations and insurance proceeds--for a net total cost to the City of \$4,310,869.
