Timeline of City of Los Angeles Towing Contracts

- 1995 Lawsuit filed to allow competitive bidding for city impound contracts. Towing companies that have contracts with the city are accused of being an "old boys network" and where businesses and contracts are handed down from fathers to sons locking out new companies from obtaining these contracts.
- 1996 Competitive bidding ordinance for impound contracts goes into effect.
- 1998 Three towing garages sue city alleging unfair practices regarding competitive bidding process.

 In 1998, the Los Angeles Times reported that the OPGA members paid over \$100,000 to lobbyist Ken Spiker in 1997. Spiker served for years as chief legislative analyst, top advisor to the city council.
- 2008 Report released of 2007 operational and compliance audit is conducted by Controller Laura N. Chick of the Los Angeles Police Commission's oversight and management of the city impound contracts. Audit found 15 or 20 OPGs did not include lien processing fees in their gross revenues, which resulted in a \$1 million underpayment of franchise fees due to the City. OPGA said lien fee should not be considered revenue. Office of Finance and Police Commission are involved in OPGA contracts.

Current Fees as set forth by the Police Commission are as follows:

- Towing: \$114.50 per hour Standard Vehicles
 \$213.50 per hour Heavy Duty
- Storage: \$35.50 per day Standard Vehicles
 \$48.50 \$60.50 per day Heavy Duty Vehicles
 (depending on vehicle size)
- · City of L.A. Vehicle Release Fee: \$115.00 per each vehicle released
- 10% City Parking Occupancy Tax collected on storage fees

The OPGs remitted over \$18 million dollars to the City of Los Angeles in 2009. This revenue consisted of the following:

- Franchise Fees (7% Gross Receipt Fee)
- Vehicle Release Fees
- City Parking Occupancy Taxes
- Delinquent Parking Citation fees remitted to the City from lien sale excess fees
- · Proceeds from sales of Forfeited Vehicles
- * For vehicles that are sold for more than the charges against them, towing companies **must** remit the excess fees to either the local city for delinquent parking citation fees due or the remaining balance of the overage to the State of California, Department of Motor vehicles. While there are hundreds of companies in the state that conduct lien sales, the Los Angeles OPGs combined account for 60% of the excess overages submitted annually to the Department of Motor Vehicles.
