

These maps are evidence that contradict statements made by Councilmember Jose Huizar's Legislative Deputy Erick Martell. Mr. Martell has stated that posting of Rose Hills signs will not be within an already established community.

These maps make it clear that any posting of Rose Hills signs will be done within an already established community, namely the community of El Sereno.

The posting of Rose Hills' signs is an attempt to rename an area of El Sereno WITHOUT going through the City Clerk's Naming/Renaming process. The posting of Rose Hills' signs must stop and the proper naming/renaming process followed.

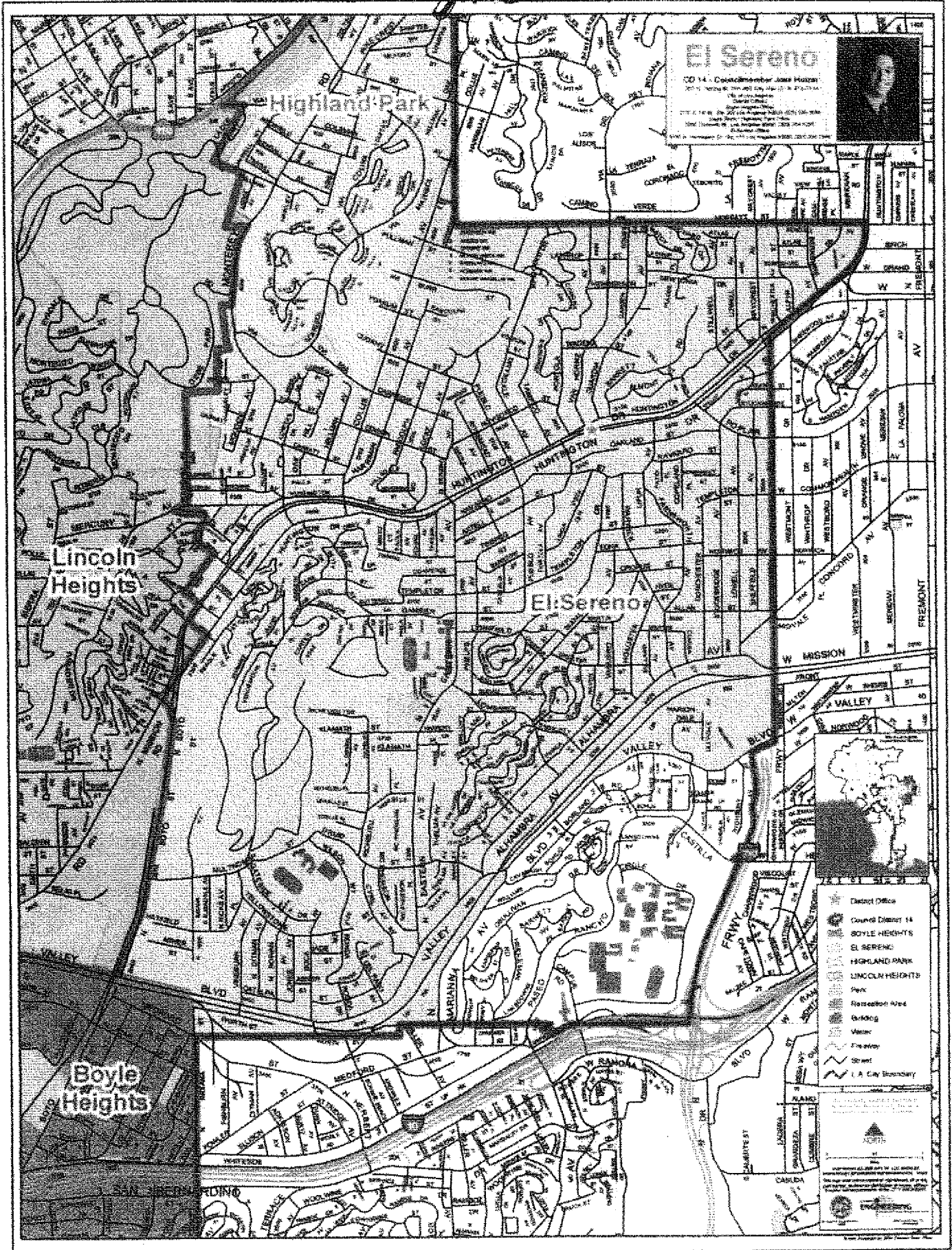
Requested documents made under California's Public Records Act have not been available for review. This is a clear violation of our rights and the law.

Legislative Deputy Erick Martell stated that the requested documents show when Rose Hills received official recognition as a community by the City of Los Angeles as well as the exact boundaries of this said community.

Despite verbal and written PRA request for these documents, their existence remains unknown. We suspect they do not exist; the existence of these documents must be verified before going any further.

If these documents do not exist, Motion 11-2057 is null. Instead, Rose Hills' advocates must follow the City Clerk's Naming/Renaming Process.

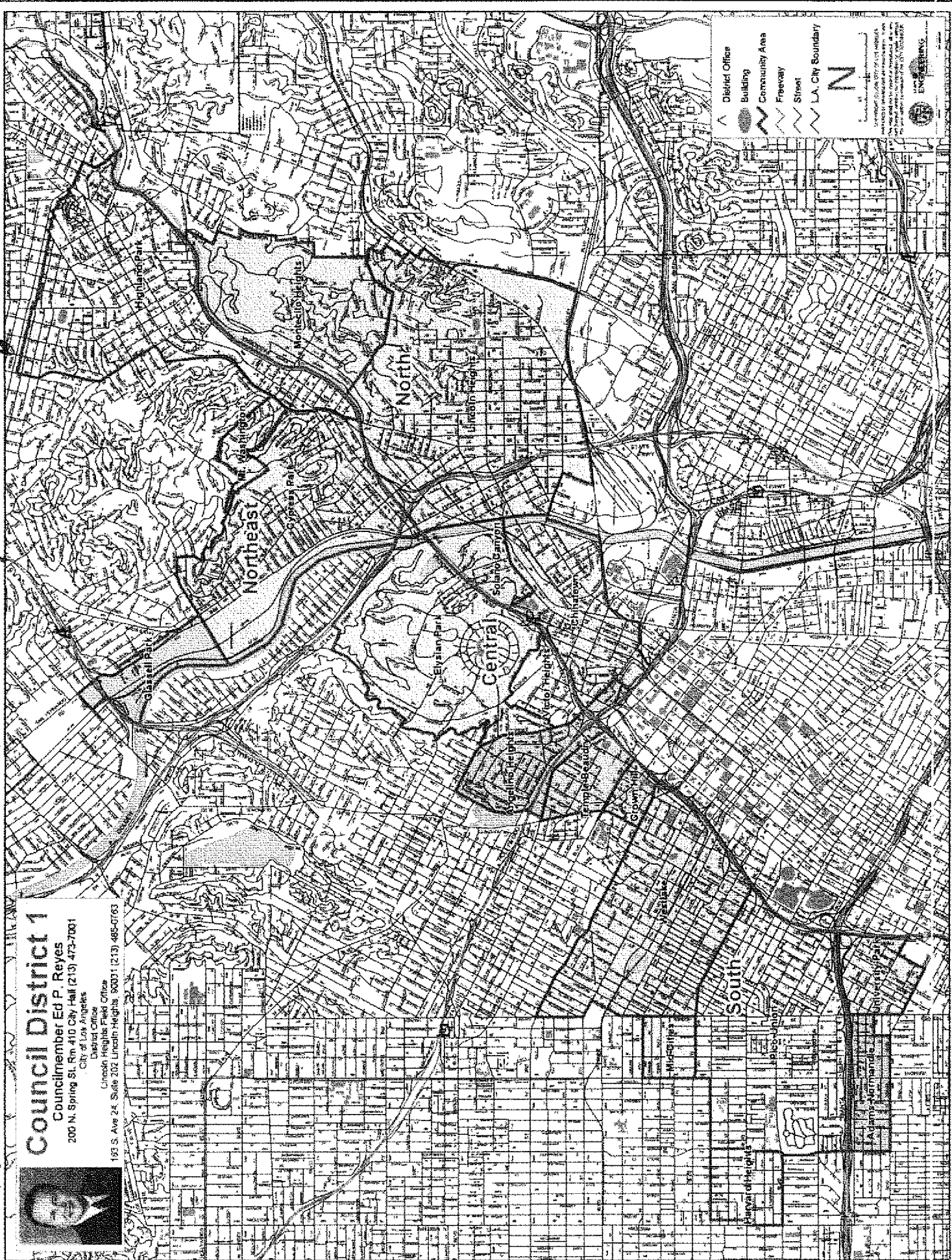


NO ROSE HILLS COMMUNITY IS SHOWN IN CD-14
