**Your HOUSING, COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE
MAJORITY REPORT**

is as follows:

HOUSING, COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Council oversight for the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles.

Recommendations for Council action (Yes: Cárdenas, Reyes, and Wesson; No: Perry):

1. REQUEST the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) report to the Housing, Community and Economic Development Committee (HCED) on a quarterly basis and also on an ad hoc basis as requested by the HCED Committee, particularly on issues that are identified for discussion by the HCED Committee.
2. RECEIVE and FILE the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) report dated May 25, 2012 relative to Council Oversight of HACLA.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on December 12, 2012, the Housing, Community and Economic Development (HCED) Committee considered a CLA report dated May 25, 2012 relative to oversight of the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) by the Council, pursuant to Council Action of October 23, 2009 as initiated by Motion (Perry – Garcetti) (Council File [CF] No. [09-1731](#)) and Council action of February 7, 2012 as initiated by Motion (Perry – Garcetti – Zine) (CF No. [09-1731-S1](#)), and pursuant to Motion (Alarcón – Huizar) (CF No. 11-2105).

The Committee moved to request that HACLA report to the HCED Committee on a quarterly basis and also on an ad hoc as requested by the Committee, particularly on issues that are identified for discussion by the Committee. Furthermore, the Committee Chair noted that it is always within the authority of the Council to bring up items and make stricter requirements in the future if it chooses to do so. Additionally, the Committee recommended to receive and file the CLA report.

The Councilmember from Council District 9, who solely voted against the request to HACLA and the recommendation to receive and file the CLA report dated May 25, 2012, stated her intention to submit a Minority Report to approve the recommendations in that CLA report. The Minority Report is for information purposes unless it is adopted by a motion to be substituted for the majority report.

This majority report is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
