Silver Lake Forward's core values prioritize access, beauty and conservation in the development of public space around the former Silver Lake Reservoir and its environs. We hold these as central to the City's obligation to our lake, land and community. We believe access to the Reservoir Complex must be safe and convenient for all citizens, including pedestrians, cyclists, transit users and motorists.

Toward this goal, we have reviewed the report commissioned by Council District 4, "Rowena Avenue, Waverly Drive, Angus Street Cut-Through Traffic Study" and support its recommendations and improvement options for addressing cut-through traffic on Angus Street and Waverly Drive, and Rowena Avenue Improvements Option 1. We DO NOT support Rowena Avenue Improvement Options 2,3,or 4.

We also support further engineering and budget analysis by LADOT towards implementation of these recommendations and request that the motion before the City Council be amended to make safety the main criteria by which any recommendation is evaluated.

We thank Councilmember David Ryu and the CD-4 staff for their proactive efforts towards improving the safety and beauty of public space in the Silver Lake community.
