MOTION

The Street Furniture Revenue Fund provides funds for transit related projects, sidewalk projects, curb / sidewalk improvements, beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto for each Council District.

There is a great need for Council staff to focus on transit related projects, sidewalk projects, curb / sidewalk improvements, beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto in Council District 4.

This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD-4 and deserves financial assistance from the City. Sufficient funds are available in the Street Furniture Revenue Fund which could appropriately be transferred to the CD-4 office budget for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$250,000 in the Council District 4 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D Dept. 50 be transferred to the Council District 4 portion of the Council Fund No. 100-28, Account No. 1010 (Salaries - General) to provide funding for any aspect of efforts involving transit related projects, sidewalk projects, curb / sidewalk improvements, beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto, as well as for general services to the community in Council District 4.
