Since 2005, the City of Los Angeles (City), Los Angeles Bureau of Sanitation (LASAN) has been receiving annual payments of about one million dollars from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) under the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program. CalRecycle has an annual appropriation of \$10,500,000 to distribute to eligible cities and counties to expend on new or existing programs related to beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities. Each municipality is eligible to receive \$5,000 or an amount calculated by CalRecycle on a per capita basis, whichever is greater. On March 1, 2016, CalRecycle issued a revision to the governing rules of its Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program requiring all applicants that would like to continue receiving funds from the program to submit a resolution approved by the governing body.

LASAN has finalized such a resolution (attached) and requests approval from the Board of Public Works (Board) to forward the said resolution to the City Council for final approval. Payments from CalRecycle are deposited into Fund 556, Department 50 Account No. 336203.

IT IS THEREFORE MOVED, that the Board approves the attached resolution and forward it to the City Council for final approval.
