

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to a request for authority to submit an application for any and all payment programs offered by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) under the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION, as required by the CalRecycle, authorizing:

- a. The submittal of an application for any and all payment programs offered by the CalRecycle under the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program.
- b. The Director, Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to execute and submit on behalf of the City of Los Angeles all related documents necessary to implement and secure payments.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Public Works reports that there is no fiscal impact to the General Fund. The CalRecycle has an annual appropriation of \$10.5 million to distribute to eligible cities and counties to expend on new or existing programs related to beverage containers recycling and litter cleanup activities.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a meeting held on May 18, 2016, the Energy and Environment Committee considered a report from the Board of Public Works dated April 27, 2016 and a Resolution relative to a request for authority to submit an application for any and all payment programs offered by the CalRecycle under the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution as detailed above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
