File 12-0303 Hollywood Community Update

According to 2005 TIMP, quote "In Hollywood, there are a number of reasons why the standard street dimensions cannot be achieved or may not be appropriate given the character of the streets and the land uses along them. One of the reasons that many streets in Hollywood will not likely ever be widened is the historic nature of the area, particularly the Hollywood Walk of Fame. *There are also many historic buildings in Hollywood that would have to be displaced to implement the roadway cross sections called for by the current standard street dimensions.*" end quote.

The 1949 proposed Parkway System planned for two freeways thru Hollywood which were never built for north/south and East/west pass-through commuter traffic. Hollywood cannot tolerate additional density that would increase traffic congestion to gridlock levels. This problem is unmitigatable.
