

AMENDING MOTION

I MOVE that Item 15 on today's Council Agenda (12-0307-S3), be referred back to the Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee, due to the fact that the Council recently took action to create a multi- year discount program for the equine license fee in order to encourage more horse owners to license their animals, and adding a new administration fee would be counter productive; and

I FURTHER MOVE, that the Equine Advisory Committee, as well as relevant Neighborhood Councils, be asked to weigh-in on the proposal to increase horse license fees to include a \$3 administration fee; and

I FURTHER MOVE, that the City Council instruct the Department of Animal Services to prepare a report for the Personnel and Animal Welfare with an update on the multi-year license ordinance, including how many people have purchased horse licenses since the implementation of the ordinance, how many of these licenses have been multi-year licenses, how many of the horse licenses were purchased online, and how the horse licensing numbers compare to previous years.
