WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during all or certain hours of the day;

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 requires that with the exception of parking restrictions in alleys, a resolution or ordinance that restricts the parking of vehicles, including vehicles that are six or more feet in height, during all or certain hours of the day, will only apply in areas in which signs are posted giving notice of the restrictions;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in heights during the hours of 9:00 AM through 3:00 PM on the North side of Santa Monica Boulevard 500 feet east of Manning Avenue;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of the parking restrictions on the North Side of Santa Monica Boulevard 500 feet east of Manning Avenue.
