Dear Councilmembers Buscaino and Harris-Dawson:

On August 14, 2018, our Board voted 14-0-0 to oppose the proposed change via re:code LA in division 13.2 covering General Procedural Elements which refers to the required notification method for a Public Hearing. The proposed change would be that when more than 1,000 property owners are required to be notified of a Public Hearing, that publication of the hearing notice in a newspaper of general circulation may substitute, rather than a mailed notice to all of the impacted property owners. Given that very few of our stakeholders now subscribe to any type of physical newspaper, a notification of a Public Hearing by that method only would be entirely inadequate.
