COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, JOBS AND BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE relative to the status of all fees charged for film and television productions and the impact of waiving all City fees for television pilots filmed substantially in the City.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Garcetti – Krekorian):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to report on the status of all fees charged for film and television productions and the impact of waiving all City fees for television pilots filmed substantially in the City.
2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Fire Department, Recreation and Parks Department, and Department of Transportation to report on the status of fees charged for film and television productions.
3. REQUEST that FilmLA develop a fee waiver incentive to support television pilot productions filmed substantially in the City.


Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
