Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Garcetti – Krekorian):

- 2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Fire Department, Recreation and Parks Department, and Department of Transportation to report on the status of fees charged for film and television productions.
- 3. REQUEST that FilmLA develop a fee waiver incentive to support television pilot productions filmed substantially in the City.
