

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a new Workforce Investment Board (WIB) - Local Elected Officials (LEO) Agreement.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. APPROVE the WIB-LEO Five-Year Agreement between the Office of the Mayor, the City Council and the WIB of the City of Los Angeles (Attachment 2 of the Chief Legislative Analyst [CLA] report dated October 8, 2013, attached to Council file No. 12-0602-S2), subject to the approval by the City Attorney as to form and legality.
2. AUTHORIZE the Mayor and the President of the City Council to execute the WIB-LEO Agreement (Attachment 2 of the CLA report dated October 8, 2013, attached to Council file No. 12-0602-S2), effective for the period October 16, 2013 through October 16, 2018, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
3. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD) and the Personnel Department, to develop and implement the necessary personnel and budgetary actions to move the WIB Executive Staff from the Office of the Mayor to the EWDD, and report to the Economic Development Committee in 15 days.
4. INSTRUCT the EWDD to review the current evaluation system for WorkSource Center operators and develop recommendations for a more transparent, efficient and improved evaluation process for WorkSource Center operators and report to Council in 30 days.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the CLA. The CAO has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on December 10, 2013, the Economic Development Committee considered a joint report from the WIB and the Community Development Department (now known as the EWDD) dated December 17, 2012, and a report from the CLA dated October 8, 2013, relative to authorization of a new five-year WIB-LEO agreement.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approval of the recommendations in the CLA report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
