## MOTION

Founded in 1907, the Glassell Park community is one of the city's oldest neighborhoods and has grown into a vibrant community.

Named for Andrew Glassell, a landowner who originally subdivided the district in 1907, Glassell Park features diverse residential neighborhoods and robust commercial corridors along Eagle Rock Boulevard, Verdugo Road and San Fernando Road.

In the last decade, the Fletcher Square area of Glassell Park has also become a thriving residential and commercial center with the addition of Juntos Park, the Glassell Park Community Garden, the Glassell Park Senior and Community Center, the Rio Vista housing development and other community assets.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the intersection at Fletcher Drive and San Fernando Road in Glassell Park be named "Fletcher Square" and direct the Department of Transportation to erect permanent ceremonial signage to this effect.
