Dear Honorable Members:

We, Todd Rubinstein and Debra George declare that we are the President and the Parks Committee Chair, respectively of the Encino Neighborhood Council (NC) and that on March 26<sup>th</sup>, a Brown Act noticed public meeting was held by this NC with a quorum of fourteen (14) board members present and that by a vote of 13 yes, 0 no, and 1 abstention the Encino NC adopted the following resolution as a Community Impact Statement:

The Encino Neighborhood Council supports expanding the Park Ranger Program to Optimum Program Level. We request that Park Rangers be assigned daily to the heavily used Sepulveda Basin regional park where there is a strong need for the positive educational and enforcement role of the Park Rangers.
